Victory in Jesus!

I was born into a non-Christian family. We never had a Bible and I don't remember knowing anything about it until I was about 7 years old when I went to live with a family who adopted me about 2 years later.



The family that adopted me were religious, but also abusive. I figured there couldn't be a God, because why would God allow me to be abused by a family that was supposed to love me? I stayed away from the Bible and didn't pick it up for many years.

I started smoking at 8 years old, and was having a lot of behavioral issues because of the abuse. I eventually ran away at 13 and ended up in state care again. I was 13 when I tried pot for the first time. I was bounced around from one foster home to the next where I met other kids who were doing drugs and alcohol. I quickly fell into the role of the "troubled teenager." At 14 I tried mescaline and alcohol. Schnapps was my favorite then because it tasted like candy. Many times I would be molested by men who would get me drunk until I passed out. I was feeling pretty worthless when my social worker reinforced that by putting me in a drug and alcohol rehab and then in a state hospital for over a year, telling me that nobody wanted me because I was crazy and worthless and I should be locked up for the rest of my life.

I ran away from the hospital three times and when I turned 18, I went back to my social worker and demanded that she release me from state care. She told me she could have me committed to the state hospital until I was 25. "I told her that I've already run away three times, if you couldn't keep me then, so what makes you think you can keep me now." After she signed the papers, I left for California where I met more people who did drugs and I was introduced to cocaine, crack to be specific. Soon I had a \$200.00 a day habit. Not long after that I was selling myself as a prostitute. After being arrested twice, I decided it was time to move on.

I moved to Oregon with a boyfriend and continued on in my self destruction. A week before my 19th birthday I met someone who had pure cocaine. We rocked it up and it took me 5 days to come down. I remember saying, "Please God, help me get off this and I'll never touch it again." After 5 days I was clean and I never touched it again. I never gave God another thought about getting off the other drugs.

I have 5 children, by 3 different men, was married to one of them but he died 12 years later from diabetes complications. All my children have been taken from me and adopted out. Every single man I was with abused me. I had been dating a raging alcoholic for the last 2 years when we had been kicked

out of our room for fighting. I ended up staying in an abandoned building with a drug dealer when Jesus came calling.

I had been attending bible study at the Salt Lake City Mission, sporadically at first. Then slowly coming every day. Everyone saw a change in me and I felt it as well. I prayed daily for God to get me out of the abandoned building but I didn't expect what He had planned. One day I lost my drivers license and I was fraught with stress. I thought it may be back in the building but it got raided that night. I had no where to go and no clothes. I was angry at God and cried to some of my Christian friends at the mission, "Why me? Why is God doing this to me? Haven't I done everything asked of me?"

My friends from the Salt Lake City Mission tried to get me into a Christian women's shelter but they had no room, nor did the public shelter. All the doors seemed to be closing and I didn't know what to do. I cried out, "OK God. I give up. I give it all to You. I don't know what you want me to do so You show me what You want for me." We went to the YWCA and they had a bed for me. I began to thank God for His mercy!

Ever since I repented and surrendered to God, so many doors have been opening for me. I now have my own apartment with a warm bed to sleep in. I attend all the bible studies I can and I have new, clean clothes given to me regularly, as my life is changing in exciting and positive ways. God is truly providing everything I need as I learn to trust Him and live responsibly for my own actions, working hard to be a blessing to others and God Himself. I PRAISE GOD!

Now I know I'm forgiven I can forgive other also. I now have a godly desire to pray for my ex-boy friend. I feel sad when I think about him and ask God to help him. I know God will answer my prayers. I just hope it's not too late. Maybe you can help me pray for him also. All praise and glory to Jesus!
